

Time Travelers and Science Sleuths Camp Information

In order for participants to get the most from the program, it is recommended that they attend the program each day and have an interest in learning about history and/or science.

The program fees include field trip admission, all program supplies, a camp t-shirt and an open house. Guest speakers and visits to portions of the park that are normally closed to the public round out the activities.

Send your child daily with a lunch, snacks, water bottle, and wearing closed-toe shoes (i.e. sneakers). Trip destinations are subject to change. Please note - the site is closed on all field trip days.

A week before camp begins parents will receive an information handbook and an emergency information card. Please be sure to review the information in the handbook and fill out the emergency card completely. The emergency card must be given to the site staff on the first day of camp.
