Additional Soccer and Baseball Field permit information

Rental Information:

Reservations are required for organized groups and for guaranteed use of fields. Groups are responsible for set-up, clean-up, lining, and nets for soccer goals. Please review the full list of terms and conditions of use before requesting a permit.

Permit Requirements:

- ✓ Completion of facility use request form, signed permit and payment.
- ✓ Read, sign and abide by Athletic Field Rules and Regulations.
- ✓ Provision of \$1,000,000 per occurrence general liability insurance as required by the Department holding the County additionally insured and the named certificate holder. Insurance is required prior to field use.

Required Minimums:

- 8-hour minimum per day on weekends
- 2-hour minimum per day on weekdays or within three weeks of a weekend date

Hours and field availability vary per season and park.

Seasons:

Fields are open mid-March through mid-November. Specific dates are announced based on weather and are subject to change. A fine is charged for play on closed fields.
